Compliance with competition law in FiCom

- Finnish Federation for Communications and Teleinformatics FiCom has several working groups appointed from the representatives from member companies, which guide the work of the association and form common positions on lobbying issues important to the industry.
- Confidential information may not be discussed during or in these meetings. Confidential information is any information that is
 - recent
 - not available at the same level of accuracy from public sources, and
 - which may have an (even theoretical) effect on the competitive and market behavior of member companies.
- It is therefore forbidden to discuss, inter alia, prices, factors affecting prices, information from which prices can be deduced, purchase or sales volumes, production targets, market areas and shares, future investments, cost structure, customers and their purchases, and other technical or commercial secrets.
- Information older than 12 months is considered historical and may be exchanged.
